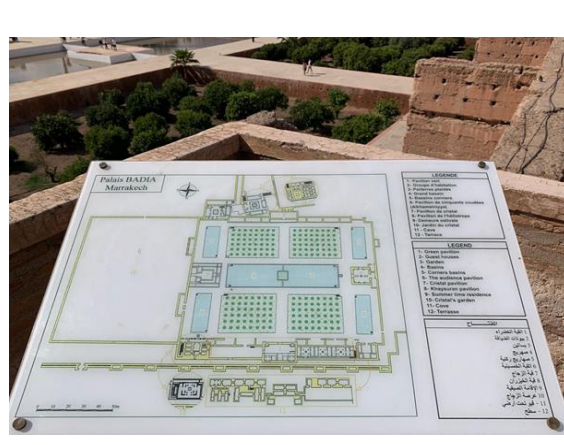

i. Compiling information on a place of our interest – shared built heritage

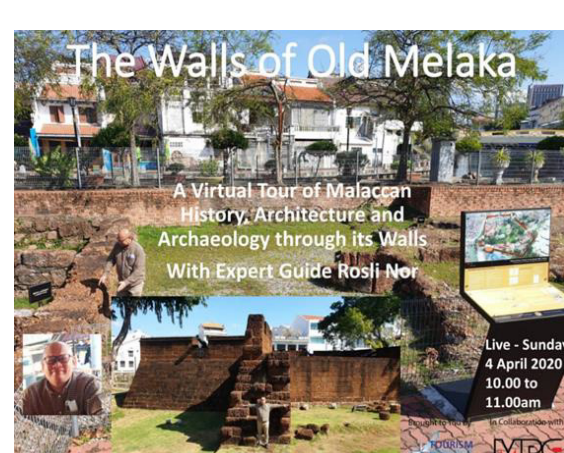
ii. Exchanging information and knowledge with experts from the local/ international teams via email or other virtual platform prior to any physical visits

The International Scientific Committee on Shared Built Heritage is established in accordance with the ICOMOS Statutes adopted at the 19th General Assembly in Delhi, in December 2017; the Ethical Principles adopted in Florence, November 2014; the Rules of Procedure of the International Council on Monuments and Sites adopted pursuant to the ICOMOS Statutes; the Eger Xi'an Principles 2008; the Malta Guidelines for ISCs 2009; and the Dubrovnik Valetta Principles 2010.

Following the ICOMOS requirements, the ISCSBH By-Laws were revised. The board has made efforts preparing a new version, and the voting members from each country helped with the revision work. The revised By-Laws were sent to ICLAFI for appraisal.
